

RULES FOR ANTIQUE TRACTOR PULL

- 1. All tractors must be registered before 1:00 pm.**
- 2. It is the responsibility of the Owner/Operator to enter their tractor in the proper class.**
- 3. All tractors must be introduced prior to 1960 and must be original or restored tractors only.**
- 4. (a) Tractors must meet weight as per class entered specifies.**
(b) Participants shall be allowed a 100 lb. grace.
(c) ALL DRIVERS MUST weigh-in before each pull.
- 5. Front end of tractor lifting more than 20 inches will be stopped by the Track Judge.**
- 6. All entries will pull from a standard draw bar hitch and will not be higher than 20 inches measured from the ground and stationary in all directions.**
- 7. Hands on fenders and tractor in neutral while being hitched to boat.**
- 8. Pull of 200 feet is considered a “full pull”. If more than one participant obtains a full pull, there will be a pull off. Winner of pull off can enter in the next higher weight class.**
- 9. The participant shall be allowed a 100 lb. grace weight to enter into the next higher weight class, if desired.**
- 10. Drivers under 16 must have written parental permission.**
- 11. The Decision of the Track Judge is final.**

****DUTIES:**** It is requested, every puller be responsible for track duties during the pull. This would only apply if a puller does not have an entry in the competing class on the track.
